Covid-19:-

Coronavirus restrictions still impact heavily on our ability to generate income.

Covid has resulted in the cancellation of all 2020 and some 2021 wedding receptions.

This current lockdown since 5th January has resulted in the loss of all our regular hirers.

Nevertheless I do expect the majority of them to return once we are permitted to reopen.

We are permitted to reopen with limited activities from Step 3 of governments' plan which should be 17th May, although social distancing measures would still need to be in place. It is not until we reach Step 4 (21st June) that all restrictions will be lifted (both social distancing requirements and activity restrictions).
