## Looking forward for the rest of the year.

Back in January my budget for the year was a surplus of £8,450. Since then we have received an unexpected Restart Grant of £8,000.00 from the government. I am now estimating a surplus for the year of around £16,500.00, thus I am now expecting our bank balance to be around £14,800 at the end of December.

In light of all these generous government grants for our lockdowns, I am recommending we share £2,000 of these grants with the PCC in compensation for the cancellation of the 2020 Fete. I am still expecting the 2021 Fete to proceed and to split this year's fete profit with the PCC.
