Repairs.

Still waiting for stonemason to come free to repair our entrance wall.

The grading of the field did not happen before the wet spell at the end of 2021, as we were waiting to hear from PCC and their new team who will manage the field. When this happens it would be best scheduled for after the fete in early September.

Improvements.

I have not progressed the Brown Sign project over the Christmas break, but it will reach the top of my "To Do List" in the next week or two.

Other.

The Calor tank was refilled on January 7th. Whilst there the driver spotted a connection joint that had too much play (although not enough to leak) and will set in motion the Calor engineer to attend and fix.

Grave diggers for the new churchyard have been spotted driving vehicles and diggers on both our path and the field adjacent to the path. This does cause some ruts and damage to the field.

The car park edges have started to show signs of weeds growing through, I will apply some weedkiller once the ground becomes drier.

2021 Improvements.

Money was invested in improving the kitchen facilities, notably the tablecloths, cutlery, salt & peppers, trays and chopping boards. An outside tap and hosepipe was fitted adjacent to the car park. The Annexe was fitted out with new shelves to provide space for a new ride-on mower and for storage. New planters were installed adjacent to the south wall. These planters and the eastern edge of the car park were planted with bedding plants for the summer. The whole village has been delighted.
