The PCC were very pleased to hear about the monies raised for the various charitable projects. The jumble sale raised £627.94 for the BBC Children in Need. The Andy Jackson concert raised £200.00 for the Salvation Army appeal for homeless at Christmas. Our Christmas Craft Fayre raised £171.00 for the proposed new mother and toddler group. They were delighted with the success of the returning monthly lunch club with around 40 people attending and 15 home deliveries.

The services in January (8th & 22nd) were to be held in the Hall due to the coldness of the Church in consideration of the vulnerable nature of many of the congregation.

A further £8,000 was agreed to be transferred to the PCC from the surplus of our bank balance.
